In 1996, Laura co-founded the Council of Women World Leaders. In 1997, she co-founded The White House Project. From 1992 to 1996, as director of the Women's Leadership Project, she interviewed 15 current and former women presidents and prime ministers, which is chronicled in her book and video documentary, Women World Leaders.

Laura received the Westinghouse Award of Excellence for her contribution to women and minorities in the work place.

She is the author of a book on workplace diversity, The Loudest Duck.
