Sachiko will speak about the importance of financial freedom for women, based on her own long experience working in the financial industry in both Japan and the United States.

Sachiko spent a total of 20 years on Wall Street (Moody's Structured Finance Analyst, Lehman Brothers Fixed Income Research, Kidder Peabody ABS, MBS Institutional Sales), and introduced hedge fund capital in the Japanese institutional markets in both New York and Tokyo. She also served as Executive Vice President at UBP (Union Bancaire Privee)

Investments Japan, and was responsible for business development for fund-of-fund hedge fund products, especially targeting pension sponsors in Japan.

Sachiko founded SAIL in New York in 2001, and re-started its operation in Tokyo in 2009. SAIL is a Registered Investment Adviser under Japan's Financial Services Agency (FSA) and uniquely focuses on asset allocation for the benefit of investors who seek long-term capital preservation, and also offers an individual wealth accumulation "my own portfolio" program.

She is the author of several books and numerous articles on alternative investments and international finance, and has appeared on NHK broadcasts. Sachiko is a member of Japan Society of Monetary Economics and The Pension Academy of Japan. She conducts SAIL Portfolio Academy Seminars and hosts various informal study groups. She is a lecturer at Bunkyo University and Musashino University. Sachiko graduated from Keio University, and completed all Ph.D. coursework except for the dissertation in economic history at Keio's Graduate School of Economics. She was awarded a Fulbright Scholarship to study at Smith College and School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS Johns Hopkins University).
