Robert Alan Feldman is the Chief Economist. As part of Morgan Stanley's global economics team, he is responsible for forecasting the Japanese economy, financial markets and policy developments. He has served as a member of several economic study committees of various ministries of the Japanese government, and has served as a commissioner of the Japan-US Friendship Commission.

He is also a regular commentator on *World Business Satellite*, the nightly business program of TV Tokyo. Prior to joining Morgan Stanley in 1998, Robert was the chief economist for Japan for Salomon

Brothers from 1990-97. He worked for the International Monetary Fund from 1983-89, in the Asian, European and Research Departments.

Robert has a Ph.D. in Economics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, where he concentrated on international finance and development. He did his undergraduate work at Yale University, where he took BAs in both Economics and Japanese Studies, graduating phi beta kappa, summa cum laude. Before graduate school, he worked at both the Federal Reserve Bank of New York and at Chase Manhattan Bank. He has published nine books, most recently "Feldman-hakase no Nihon Keizai Saishin Kogi" ("Dr Feldman's Latest Lecture on the Japanese Economy", Bungeishunju, 2015, in Japanese).
