Izumi Kobayashi has navigated a career that has taken many twists and turns. Starting as a tea lady at a Japanese chemical company before moving to Operations at Merrill Lynch and eventually being named President and Representative Director of Merrill Lynch Japan, where she steered through the aftermath of an attempt to break into Japan's retail stock brokerage business and led the company into record earnings.

After her success as the first woman and first Japanese person to run Merrill Lynch's Japan unit, Kobayashi-san moved to the World Bank as Executive Vice President in its Multilateral Investment Guarantee Agency (MIGA), based in Washington D.C.

When her tenure with the World Bank concluded, Kobayashi-san took her career back to Japan and is currently on the Board of Directors of three listed Japanese companies: ANA Holdings Inc., Suntory Holdings Ltd. and Mitsui & Co.
