This event will be facilitated by AWF board member Lisa Twaronite, Senior Correspondent at Thomson Reuters in Tokyo. Jodi Schneider will share her insights on working in newsrooms in Tokyo and Washington and her thoughts on the future of financial journalism. She will talk about her survival strategies in what has been a male-dominated field, and also her experiences as a working mother.



Jodi Schneider came in late September 2015 to Tokyo, where she is an editor on Bloomberg's Asia Economy team, helping oversee coverage of the Bank of Japan, economic indicators and macro-economic policy in the region. She has been an editor at Bloomberg since 2010, primarily leading the team that covers the U.S. Congress and tax policy. She is also a leader of the women's community in Bloomberg's Tokyo office.

Before coming to Tokyo, she was an editor and news manager in Washington, D.C., for 20 years, handling coverage of the U.S. Congress and politics, as well as business and finance. Before Bloomberg, she held senior editing and management roles at Congressional Quarterly, U.S. News and World Report magazine and The Washington Post.

Earlier in her career, Schneider was a reporter and editor at newspapers in Wisconsin, Colorado and Florida. Before going to Washington, she was a deputy managing editor for business coverage at the Orlando (Florida) Sentinel.

Schneider is active in journalism organizations. She has co-chaired the Fourth Estate Committee at the National Press Club in Washington and is a past president of the Society of American Business Editors and Writers.

She holds a bachelor's degree in journalism from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and a master's degree from the Medill School of Journalism at Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois.
